There will be many different activities going on, and they'll be spread out across our facilities. All areas must be monitored at all times to ensure our guests' safety.

Specific assignments will be given at a team meeting prior to the start of Hopefest. Examples of Safety & Security assignments include:

- Parking Lot Security
- Building Security
- Games & Inflatables Monitoring
- Grounds Monitor

We ask that you arrive by 4:30pm to attend a team meeting. The Safety & Security Team Leader will be there to answer any questions that you may have. Safety & Security Team Leader for Hopefest 2014 will be Mike Irving.
