Thank you for looking into the Set-up & Tear Down Team. As you can tell by the name, this is the team that gets things done! The Set-up & Tear Down Team is looking for individuals that can come early and/or stay late. Set-up for Hopefest typically begins as early as at 10am.

Team members should be prepared to do some lifting & carrying. Set-up needs include setting up tents, staging, sound & lighting gear, games, tables & chairs, etc. The team will also be working side by side with the other teams to make sure that their set-up needs are met. Your Team Leader will have a list of jobs that need to be done, and can provide you with specific assignments as we prepare to start the day.

Tear down will begin at the close of Hopefest, and requires many hands. All help is GREATLY appreciated. Some responsibilities during tear down include taking down tents, staging, sound & lighting gear, tables, chairs, and games. Be sure to check with the Team Leader at closing to see where your assistance is needed. The Set-Up & Tear Down Team Leader for Hopefest 2014 will be Cliff Graves.

We ask that all Set-up & Tear Down Team members please be very conscientious while setting up and tearing down. We want to provide and maintain a safe environment for our members, guests, and volunteers.

While serving at Hopefest, it's important to remember that Hopefest serves as our annual open house to the community. While we're not necessarily putting on a Worship Service here, we do want our guests know that we care about them, and that they are always welcome here. We also want them to feel safe while they're attending Hopefest for a few hours. Remember to serve with a smile and *"always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect"* (1 Peter 3:15).
