We need to have time for final preparations before we open candy Alley to our guests.

Be prepared to hand out Treats to at least 250 children. Please do not offer face painting, crafts, or any other interactive items for the guests at Candy Alley. It will create a delay for the other kids trying to get through the line. Trunk 'R Treat is the first area that our guests experience, and we do not wish to create a bad First Impression.

As the last guests have passed through Candy Alley, please close up your vehicles, and go have some fun at Hopefest! If you have excess candy that you'd like to give out at Hopefest, please see your Team Leader. Candy Alley will close at 6:30pm, once the final guests have made their way around.

Please remember that this is the First Impression that some will see of Highland Hope, and we want everyone to experience our Radical Hospitality!
